Care and nursing

- Nursing procedures like subcutaneously and intramuscular injections, administer oxygen and tube feeding, catheterize and wound care
- Assisting nurses and doctors with complicated nursing and/or medical procedures
- Ordering, controlling, and providing medicine within limits of professional authorizations
- Watching and promoting self-nurturing and physical well-being of residents and reporting on progress and incidents
- Providing meals and drinks in cooperation with residents-assistant and offering individual daily basic life activities

- Intake new residents and start care-file
- Support to independence promoting activities for residents (e.g. house care)
- Stimulating independence residents and social interaction
- Reporting on change in psychological and physical conditions residents
- Involves external support in crisis
- Mentoring of learners when allocated

Reporting and information transfer

- Oral and written reporting and transfer
- Manages, in consultation with first responsible nurse, care files and actual care plan
- Communicates in team meetings wishes residents and representatives
- Evaluates targets and indications in care plan in team meetings and/or resident, other care professionals
